THE LONG HAUL

But before all this they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. 13 This will be your opportunity to bear witness. 14 Settle it therefore in your minds not to meditate beforehand how to answer, 15 for I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which none of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict. 16 You will be delivered up even by parents and brothers and relatives and friends, and some of you they will put to death. 17 You will be hated by all for my name's sake. 18 But not a hair of your head will perish. 19 By your endurance you will gain your lives. Luke 21:12-19

Jesus in this passage has been speaking about the end times events that include earthquakes, famines, and pestilence, terrors and great signs, but He says here before this that there will be an increase in persecution. In other words, things are going to get worse. This is evident from Jesus words in Matthew 24 and 25. But, what Jesus focused His disciples upon was the fact that there is work to do in the midst of this,

that God has a purpose and plan right in the middle of all the chaos. He said in v13 that **"This will be your opportunity to bear witness."** So rather than lamenting the difficulty of the days, Jesus would have us first of all to look for the opportunities to bear witness in the midst of them. In fact, He indicated that God will be right in the middle of the circumstances to give us the exact words to speak. He says v15 *"I will give you a mouth and wisdom which none of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict."* In other words God will be with us in whatever we face. He finally states v19 That by our endurance that our very lives will be gained. As we continue to see chaos and turmoil I want to encourage you to endure. This present trial is a long haul, a test of our endurance and patience. Persevere dear Christian, know that God is working in your and through you and has you in the place you are for such a time as this. You are right where you are needed.

4. Use private devotional and family worship during the week to prepare yourself for Sunday in moments prior to the service, meditate on what you experienced in your own worship and recall questions you left unanswered.
5. Present your self to God in the spirit of Romans 12:1-2. As you worship God , allow Him to to point out things in your life that may not please Him." Have you ever blamed God for your problems?

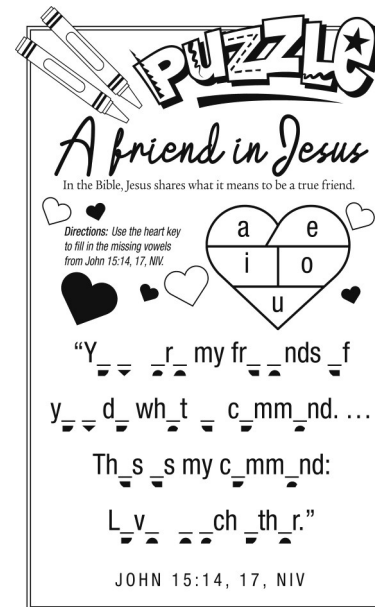
Confess it to Him and ask for His forgiveness." (*Making the Grade* by Larry Burkett)
