STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT "RIGHTS OR RESPONSIBILITIES"

"Everything is permissible—but not everything is beneficial. Everything is permissible—but not everything is constructive. Nobody should seek his own good, but the good of others." (1 Corinthians 10:23-24 NIV)

I believe that we are so conscious of our rights today that our "rights" will ultimately cost us our freedom.

To be responsible means to be accountable for our actions. Christ said His followers must be willing to surrender their rights and become His stand-ins.

We can be truly thankful that God's contract with us is binding and firm. Otherwise, He might really give us what we deserve.

We read in Matthew 20 about various workers who were hired during the day at an agreed sum. At the end of the day, those who had worked all day got paid the same wage as those who had worked only one hour, and they were grumbling at the landowner because they thought it wasn't fair. The issue wasn't whether the wage was sufficient—it was that someone else got a better deal, and that wasn't "right."

It is inconceivable to think that our Lord would have made an agreement with someone and then changed His mind and tried to negotiate a better deal. We must decide to fulfill our responsibilities—regardless of "rights."

Say with the psalmist, "The Lord is my portion; I have promised to keep Thy words" (Psalm 119:57)." (Rights or Responsibilities by Larry Burkett)

In March, the Unified Budget giving of \$14,312 fell short of meeting the actual expenditures by \$933 and giving for the year has exceeded expenditures by \$4,176. The short fall in March was primarily due to non-recurring expenses. We had \$360 given for the 2022 America for Christ Offering. We raised \$2324 for disaster relief for those families who lost homes, buildings, and vehicles in the recent Reno County fires.

Let us always fulfill our responsibilities to the Lord regardless of our rights. Lord, may we seek the good for others not just for ourselves. — Rich McCullum
