## STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT

### "Sacrificial Giving"

*"He said, 'Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all of them; . . . she out of her poverty put in all that she had to live on' " (Luke 21:1-4)*

"Sacrificial giving with a right attitude is possible only for Christians submitted to God. In the United States, giving sacrificially is almost unknown. Worldly attitudes have clouded our thinking and dulled our sensitivity to others.

God will not allow His work to tarry for lack of funds. He will redistribute the necessary funds to Christians who have the correct attitudes—primarily those who are seeking His will and are willing to sacrifice their luxuries for the needs of others.

The use of our money is a very objective measure of our commitment to Jesus Christ and to His work. Christians who bypass God's work because they refuse to experience even a slight discomfort have missed the mark.

Sacrificial giving is possible for those who have a little as well as those who have much. All Christians can give sacrificially.

Begin to sacrifice a small portion from your wants or desires for the needs of others. Ask God to lay their needs on your heart and then put your commitment to sacrificial giving into action." (*Sacrificial Giving* by Larry Burkett)

In January, the Unified Budget giving of \$16,757 exceeded the actual expenditures by \$971. The giving this month was good considering we had a snow day on one Sunday. We expended \$2584 in designated funds to cover the cost of snow removal and repairs in the parlor from roof damage from heavy snow.

May we all find joy in sacrificial giving so we may continue to meet the needs of those that God lays on our hearts and reach the lost so they may know the Lord. — Rich McCullum

### Hosanna in the Highest

The phrase "Hosanna in the highest" appears in the Bible, specifically in the New Testament, during the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. This is the relevant verse in Matthew 21:9 The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna" to the Son of David!" Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Hosanna in the highest!" In this context, "Hosanna" is an exclamation of praise and adoration. The people were acknowledging Jesus as the Messiah (Son of David) and expressing their joy and reverence as He entered Jerusalem. "Hosanna in the highest" emphasizes the highest heavens rejoicing in this momentous event.
