


### From Pastor Ron's Desk

# STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT "GIFTS THAT WE BRIBG TO CHRIST"

"And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankin-cense, and myrrh." (Matthew 2:11b. (NKJV))

"As the wise men of old presented precious gifts to the manger King in an act of worship, so we today must bring our gifts to lay at the feet of the Christ of Christmas. In October, the Unified Budget giving of \$16,752 exceeded the actual expenditures by \$627 and the amount that giving has exceeded the expenditures for 2024 is \$22,650.

The 2024 World Mission Offering was \$580 and \$525 was raised for Samaritan's Purse to help victims of hurricanes. We have helped people with offerings and donations for Benevolence, Convoy of Hope, Open Door Pregnancy, Christian Soup Kitchen, SaltHawk Community Support, and other special offerings throughout 2024. As we bring our gifts this month for the Salvation Army Food boxes and fill the mitten tree for needy children in the community,

let us always remember those less fortunate than ourselves.

This devotional still rings true as it has the last several years. As we celebrated the birth of our Lord and Savior this month, may we never forget that He is the greatest gift that we have ever received! May we continue to worship Him the rest of this year and throughout the New Year with our gifts of sacrifice and active service!
